Assembly of the Academic Senate

The Academic Assembly is the highest authority in the UC Systemwide Academic Senate. UC Santa Barbara currently has three delegates to the Academic Assembly based on over 1,200 Senate faculty (including Emeriti).

Academic Assembly Membership: President of the University, Chair & Vice Chair of the Senate, Chairs of each Division, forty Division representatives.

UC Santa Barbara Executive Council

The Executive Council oversees and manages the work of the Divisional Standing Committees.

Executive Council Membership: Divisional Chair & Vice Chair, three Divisional Academic Assembly representatives, and the following standing committee chairs: Diversity & Equity, Faculty Issues & Awards, Graduate Council, Planning & Budget, Research & Instructional Resources, and Undergraduate Council.

UC Santa Barbara Faculty Legislature

The Faculty Legislature is the final authority for all items requiring action by the Division. Faculty are appointed by their department to serve on the Legislature. Each department is given one representative per twenty FTE. Representatives from departments with less than twenty FTE will be appointed every other year.

Faculty Legislature Membership: Divisional Chair & Vice Chair, Parliamentarian, the Chancellor, Executive Council members, faculty from each department as outlined above, seven non-Senate faculty; representatives from Graduate Student Association and Associated Students.
