

COMMITTEE ON PRIVILEGE AND TENURE
ANNUAL REPORT 2006-07

To The Faculty Legislature:

The Committee on Privilege and Tenure considers grievance cases, disciplinary cases and early termination cases. When called for, the Committee conducts hearings to determine fair and equitable outcomes on matters before it.

During AY 06-07, the Committee had no new cases, and one active case in which a faculty member made an allegation of procedural violations in a personnel case. Although mostly satisfactorily completed, finalization of this case was held over the 07-08 AY. The case was finally resolved to the satisfaction of all parties in September 2007.

The Committee considered several issues as well:

- 1) The Committee was asked if they wished to opine on the statement forwarded from the UC Committee on Academic Freedom; the Committee was willing to endorse the statement.
- 2) The Committee had no comment on the proposed Station Q hires.
